# TRI-M MUSIC HONOR SOCIETY

The Tri-M Music Honor Society is a program of the National Association for Music Education (NAfME), which focuses on creating future leaders in music education and music advocacy. Tri-M is the only music honor society for junior/middle school and high school students in United States. Tri-M recognizes students that have gone above and beyond both academically and musically. Tri-M also provides students leadership opportunities to make a difference in their community through music-based service projects. There are more than 2,100 chapters across 50 states and 15 countries. Tri-M involves more than 84,000 students in grades 6-12. Each year, student members contribute more than 750,000 service hours to their school and local communities and raise nearly \$1 million for causes they care about.

Our Tri-M Chapter #8402 was established in 2019 and assists with many aspects of the Lakeside Music Program as well as the community. Projects include Music Mentors (working with JH Music Students), Stadium/Beach/Woods Clean-Up Days, LHS Recycling Program, visiting area nursing homes to perform and do crafts with the residents, plus a whole lot more! Students are invited to join Tri-M based on grades, performance ensemble participation, service, and recommendations from their Teachers. Inductions of new members occurs each fall.

# CONCERT ETIQUETTE

These students have worked exceptionally hard in preparation for this evening's performance. The audience has come to enjoy the entertainment and inspiration of the ensemble featured. Please allow everyone the best possible atmosphere by observing the following "Guidelines of Concert Etiquette":

## Thou Shalt Not...

**TALK** – The first and greatest commandment. Stay home if you are not prepared to give your full attention to what is being performed, as well as to who is performing it.

**ARRIVE LATE OR LEAVE EARLY** – Most performances have scheduled times; try to abide by them. It is only appropriate to enter or exit the performance area between musical selections and during applause.

**CAUSE OR ALLOW DISRUPTIONS** – Small children who are crying or any child involved in other disruptive behavior should be removed from the performing area. "Crying/Disruptive babies, like all good intentions, should be carried out immediately!"

**WEAR HATS** – Wearing hats can and usually does affect the ability of people behind you to see as well as they could or should.

## Thou Shalt...

**APPLAUD AT APPROPRIATE TIMES** – It is appropriate and encouraged to applaud when the conductor enters the stage the first time and after each completed piece. Please refrain from applauding after a section or movement of a piece has been completed. Wait to applaud until the entire piece has been completed.

**APPLAUD FOR SOLOISTS** – It is appropriate and encouraged to applaud the effort of all soloists. In a jazz piece, you may applaud for a soloist after the completion of their solo even though the song may not be completed yet.

**REMAIN IN ATTENDANCE FOR THE ENTIRE PERFORMANCE** – It is inappropriate to leave or expect your child to leave after their portion of the performance has been completed. The educational benefit of a program is incomplete if it does not include listening as well as performing.

Thank you for being courteous in every way possible to the students who have worked so hard in preparation for this concert and to the members of the audience who have come to see, hear, and enjoy the performance.
