

Ashtabula County Cattlemen's Association Youth Scholarship Application for Scholarship and Guidelines

Scholarship Guidelines

- Two scholarships will be awarded. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a deserving graduating *High School Senior* who will be attending an accredited full four year college or an accredited two year technical institute in the upcoming school year. In addition, one \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a current *College Student* who is currently attending an accredited full four year college or an accredited two year technical institute. Both recipients must be residents of Ashtabula County.
- For both scholarships, the first preference by the Ashtabula County Cattlemen's Association is the scholarships be awarded to deserving students who have been involved in the beef industry as a youth. Examples of this could include: working on a family beef operation; involved with a beef project through 4-H or FFA; or working on a local beef farm.
- For both scholarships, the second preference is the scholarships be awarded to a student who is or will be studying in a beef related field at an accredited full four year college or an accredited two year technical institute.
- ➤ Previous winners of the \$1,000 High School Senior Scholarship are eligible to apply for the \$500 College Scholarship. However, the \$500 college scholarship can only be received once by a student during their college career.
- ➤ \$1,000 High School Senior Scholarship The first payment will be made to the recipient upon his/her notifying the treasurer in writing of registration in a college or technical institute and that first semester/quarter fees have been paid. The rest of the scholarship will be paid upon written verification of a 2.0 or higher grade point average (on 4.0 scale) and proof of second semester fees paid. All scholarship monies must be used between September 1, 2022 and August 1, 2023 unless other arrangements are made. Mail supporting documents to OSU Extension, 39 Wall Street, Jefferson, Ohio 44047.
- ➤ \$500 College Scholarship The first payment will be made to the recipient upon his/her notifying the treasurer in writing of the payment of the fall semester/quarter fees at a college or technical institute. The rest of the scholarship will be paid upon written verification of a 2.5 or higher grade point average (on 4.0 scale) and proof of second semester fees paid. All scholarship monies must be used between September 1, 2022 and August 1, 2023 unless other arrangements are made. Mail supporting documents to OSU Extension, 39 Wall Street, Jefferson, Ohio 44047.
- ➤ The scholarship recipients will be recognized at the 2022 Ashtabula County Cattlemen's Association Banquet TBA at a later date.

- Incomplete applications will not be considered. A complete application will include <u>all</u> of the following: (1) this four page application completed by you. (2) transcripts of all grades & credits earned in high school/college. Please allow ample time for the transcripts to be processed. College students need to include both high school and college transcripts.
- Applications must be <u>received</u> by the Ashtabula County Cattlemen's Association by 4:30 p.m. on May 1st, 2022 for consideration for the scholarship. No late applications will be considered. The information asked for in this application is necessary in order for us to determine the award winners. Please mail your application packet to:
