Qualifications

- Must be at least 17 years of age (photo ID required)
- Must have the physical ability to perform the work of the trade

Application Requirements

- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Standardized Written Examination
- Oral Interview
- Application fee of \$10

Apprenticeship

- 5 year program
- Minimum of 8,000 hours on-the-job training (OJT)
- Minimum of 144 hours of related technical instruction (RTI) per year
- Probationary Period of 1 year (2,000 hours OJT and 1 year RTI)
- Indentured to the Cleveland Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee and assigned to a signatory sheet metal contractor
- College credit received for RTI

NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

- Applicants will be required to successfully complete a standardized test (independently administered), to qualify for an interview. The test is administered on a later date and the testing agency charges a \$40 test fee.
